2007 calendar for Euronext markets

Amsterdam, Brussels, Lisbon, London, Paris, 20 November 2006

The Euronext and Euronext.liffe cash and derivatives markets will all be open Monday to Friday throughout 2007 except on the following days:

- Monday 1 January 2007 (New Year's Day)
- Friday 6 April 2007 (Good Friday)
- Monday 9 April 2007 (Easter Monday)
- Tuesday 1 May 2007¹
- Tuesday 25 December 2007 (Christmas Day)
- Wednesday 26 December 2007 (Boxing Day)

On Monday 24 December 2007 and Monday 31 December 2007, the cash markets will close at 1.00 pm GMT (2.00 pm CET) whilst Euronext.liffe will commence the closing of its derivatives contracts from midday GMT (1.00 pm CET). On these days, it is Euronext.liffe's intention to align its trading hours with those of the underlying and related markets.

On 7 May, 28 May and 27 August 2007, which are public holidays in the United Kingdom, it is anticipated that all Euronext.liffe derivatives will be available for trading with the exception of sterling-based products and UK-based commodity products.

As some other markets have not yet published their trading schedules for next year, more detailed information on the trading of relevant Euronext.liffe derivatives contracts will be published in due course.

¹ *On Tuesday 1 May 2007, certain Euronext.liffe contracts will however be open, i.e. interest rate products, UK-based commodity contracts and those derivatives for which the underlying stocks are available for trading.*
