## Version 1.0 of Universal Trading Platform NYSE Arca Europe Market Data Feed Specifications now available

We are pleased to inform clients that new Version 1.0 specifications are now available for the NYSE Arca Europe Universal Trading Platform Market Data (UTP-MD) feed.

The new NYSE Arca Europe specifications have been derived from the Universal Trading Platform Market Data Feed specifications, and separated out as NYSE Arca Europe migrates to an independent matching engine and market data publisher in London later this year. We expect this to be effective in October 2009 subject to customer readiness.

Clients should be aware of the following points:

- **Despite this new independent specification, no changes to the message formats or main connectivity details have been made in anticipation of the NYSE Arca Europe migration. Any customers with existing applications will have no mandatory changes to make.**
- **Addition of the refresh server for NYSE Arca Europe.** A refresh server dedicated to NYSE Arca Europe will be made available to members, details of which are included in the new specification. This feature will go live in parallel with the refresh server implementation for the Euronext Cash Markets. This will be available in the External User Acceptance (EUA) test environment on Monday, 28 September 2009, with a production live date to follow shortly after. This feature is independent to the London migration.
- **Configuration changes for the NYSE Arca Europe London migration.** Customers are required to pay attention to the configuration changes surrounding source IP addresses and **the retransmissions server**, which are a result of the platform moving to new hardware in London. These changes will be available for testing during the preliminary connectivity testing and dress rehearsals planned for September 2009.

**NB:** customers will only be required to take part in the dress rehearsal of Saturday, 26 September 2009; the dress rehearsal of Saturday 19 September will be purely internal.
