**PROJECT: Universal Trading Platform for European Cash Markets**

## Version 2.1 of the Universal Trading Platform Market Data Feed Specifications now available

NYSE Euronext would like to inform clients that updated Version 2.1 specifications are now available for the Universal Trading Platform Market Data (UTP-MD) feed.

This latest specification includes the final information required for developers to complete the refresh server functionality.

Clients should be aware of the following changes:

- **Confirmation of the final refresh server configuration details and live dates**
- **Miscellaneous changes, including the addition of a new value 'CLSD' in the ClassState field of the 516 Class State Change message, on the 21 September 2009**
- **The removal of NYSE Arca Europe from the UTP-MD Market Data Specifications.** As NYSE Arca Europe is moving to a separate market data publisher as part of the London migration, a separate market data specification has been created for the NYSE Arca Europe market. This new specification ("Universal Trading Platform Market Data – NYSE Arca Europe v1.0") was distributed on 3 September 2009
- **Removal of the Internet VPN service from the Universal Trading Platform Market Data External User Acceptance Environment.** The Internet VPN service for preliminary market data development has now been discontinued. An 'Exchange Simulator' is currently available for feed development purposes.

***It is important that clients review all of the changes to the specifications, which are documented in chapter 7 'Document History'.*** The new specifications and also instructions for using the 'Exchange Simulator' can be found on the Euronext website in the following location:

The refresh server is scheduled to be available in the External User Acceptance (EUA) test environment on **Wednesday, 30 September 2009**. The Production refresh server go-live date will be **Monday, 26 October 2009**.
