Revision of the CFI code

NYSE Euronext would like to advise clients of changes to the CFI code as of the end of September.

NYSE Euronext currently incorporates the CFI code provided by SIX Telekurs France when publishing its referential data. Only the first two characters of the code are included and the code is a specific SIX Telekurs code rather than a code provided by the official agency for each NYSE Euronext marketplace.

Following client requests, SIX Telekurs has decided to revise its internal allocation process and replace its two-character code by the six-character code approved by the appropriate official agency.

The current code will be reinitialised by SIX Telekurs during the weekend of 26-27 September 2009. Consequently NYSE Euronext will carry out the same changes in three stages:

- **28 September** for European stocks (NYSE Arca Europe – SmartPool)
- **29 September** for all products listed in Paris
- **30 September** for all products listed in Amsterdam, Brussels and Lisbon.

In order to allow clients time to assess the impact of this modification, the NYSE Euronext External User Acceptance (EUA) test platform will be open with the reinitialised CFI code on:

- **15 September** for all products listed in Paris
- **16 September** for all products listed in Amsterdam, Brussels and Lisbon.
