NYSE Arca Europe move to London data centre

We are pleased to confirm that NYSE Arca Europe (NAE) will begin trading from NYSE Euronext's existing data centre located in London on Monday, 19 October 2009 following the migration of the matching engine from Paris to London.

Customers will be able to validate their order entry and market data access during testing on Saturday, 17 October 2009. NYSE Arca Europe will publish a more detailed schedule of the testing timescales at the beginning of next week.

If your company did not validate your new NYSE Arca Europe SLE during the 26 September testing, 17 October will be the only opportunity to perform such a validation test prior to the migration as there is no intra-week end-to-end testing for newly created NYSE Arca Europe London SLEs.

Customers are reminded that they can perform technical connectivity tests (Telnet) to the CCGs and Universal Trading Platform (UTP-MD) market data retransmission servers at any time during the week.
