## Trade Confirmation System (TCS) availability via the new order entry protocols through the Common Customer Gateway (CCG) - update

**TCS access via new order entry protocols (UTP-Direct and FIX 4.2):**

NYSE Euronext is pleased to announce to customers that access to the TCS through the CCG for new order entry protocols (UTP-Direct and FIX 4.2) will be available to customers as follows:

- in the **External User Acceptance (EUA) test environment as of Wednesday, 16 December 2009.**
- in the **production environment as of Monday, 15 March 2010.**

Current access means will remain unchanged until further notice:

- TCS Web
- eTCS
- Legacy protocols (MMTP and FIX EN)

### Migration process:

Customers are required to submit to the Customer, Connectivity and Configuration (CCC) team, the list of existing or new SLE connections that need to access the TCS. The order form will be available in due course.

**Note:** Due to technical reasons related to TCS access, SLE session's names will be changed.

- For a migration without protocol change; all existing SLE sessions that need to access the TCS will require an order book migration. This migration will be transparent.
- For a migration from legacy protocols (MMTP/ FIX EN) to new protocols (FIX 4.2/ UTP-Direct): The migration of TCS books will not be possible.

All types of declarations that are currently available on the TCS platforms will be accessible via the UTP Direct and FIX 4.2 protocols.

**The protocols UTP Direct and FIX 4.2 can already be used to trade on the following platforms: UTP trading platform (Equities, bonds and ETF's (trackers), NYSE Arca Europe and SmartPool.**
