I. Q1 2019 HIGHLIGHTS



Q1 2019 RESULTS BOLSTERED BY ACQUISITIONS AND STRONG OPERATING PERFORMANCE

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2019

Optiq®

- Migration of Euronext Dublin to Optiq[®] trading platform executed in February 2019 and €6.7m costs synergies delivered
- Irish capital markets participants now having access to the largest single liquidity pool in Europe
- Ongoing integration of Euronext Dublin markets to Euronext harmonized rulebook



- New matching engine in Singapore, expected to be fully operational in Q4 2019, to be closer to clients worldwide and create a strong development base in the region
- Customers in various Asia-Pacific markets including Singapore, Australia and Hong Kong to benefit from an improved trading experience and connectivity



- Continued high level of commercial intensity with both listed and non-listed users
- Revenue at €5.1m, up+39.6% vs last year



- Broadening of Euronext offering towards Investor services through a Software as a Service provider of research evaluation and commission management for financial services firms
- More value for Euronext clients, asset managers and broker-dealers by addressing a strong need generated by MiFID II regulation
- Diversification of Euronext revenue profile, €1.1m revenue contribution in Q1 2019

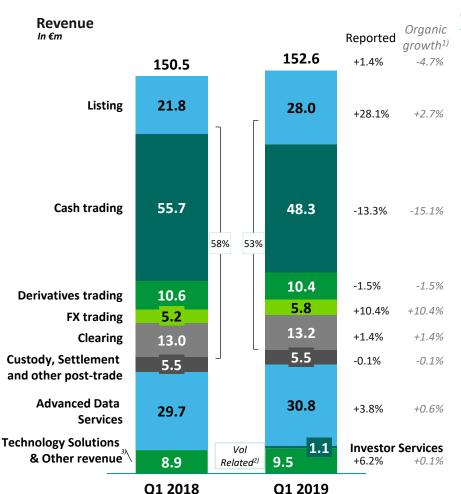




II. Q1 2019 FINANCIALS



Q1 2019 REVENUE UP +1.4%



Q1 2019 revenue up +1.4% to €152.6m (+€2.1m)

- Strong increase in listing revenue thanks to the consolidation of Euronext Dublin and the good performance of Corporate Services
- Cash trading revenue decreasing less than volumes due to improved yield and solid market share
- Spot FX revenue driven by improved market share, revenue capture and positive forex impact
- Good performance of advanced data services thanks to indices and to consolidation of Euronext Dublin
- First contribution of Investor Services (Commcise)
- Increased Group non-volume related revenue at 47% thanks to business diversification
- Non-volume related revenue to operating cost coverage ratio⁴⁾ at 114% in Q1 2019

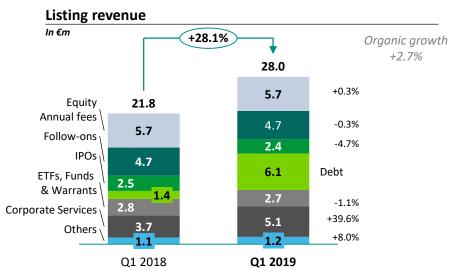

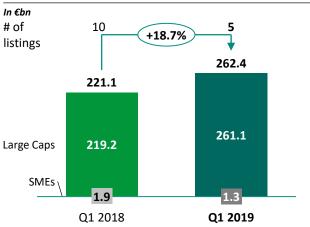
Non-volume related businesses revenue divided by operating costs (excluding D&A)

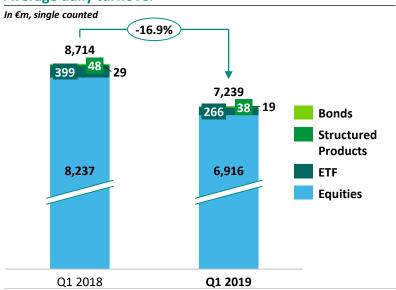

Average daily turnover³⁾

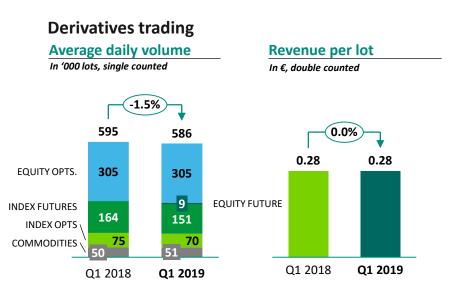

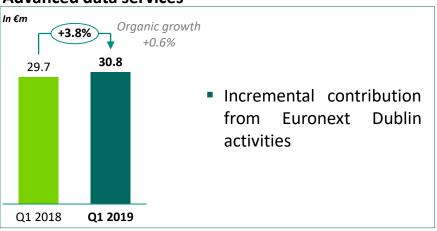

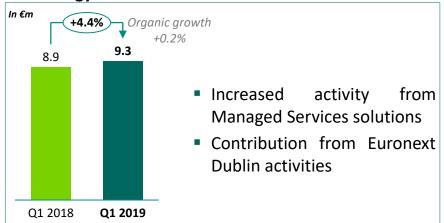

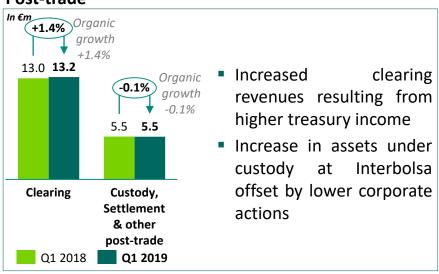

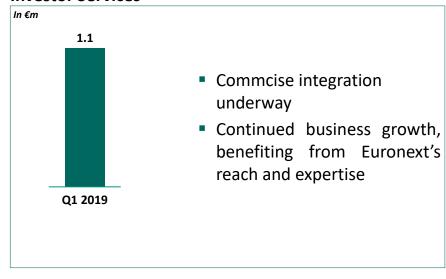

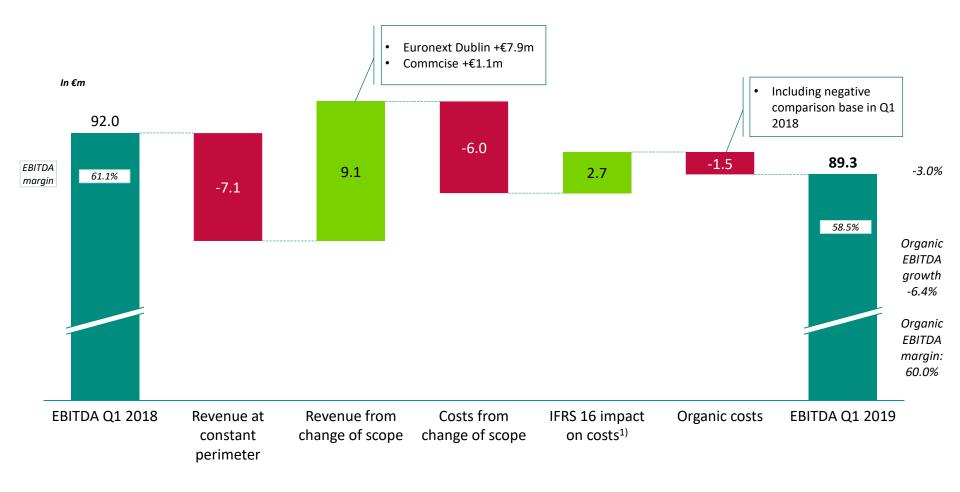

IMPACTED BY RECENT ACQUISITIONS AND SUBDUED VOLUMES

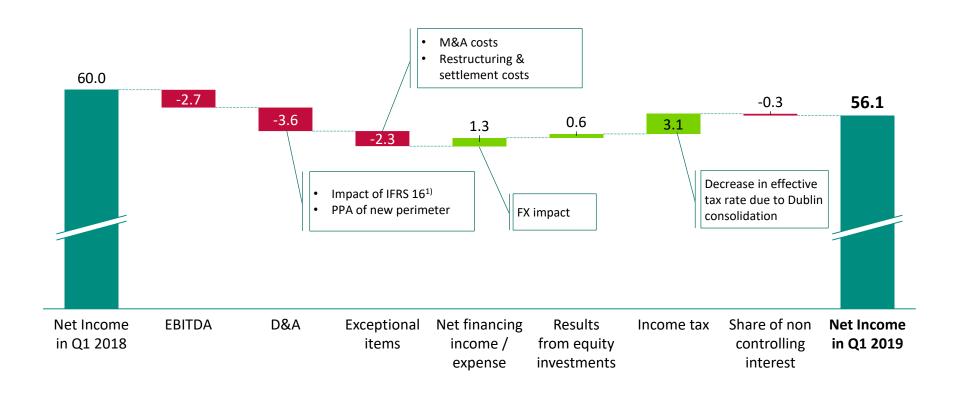




Q1 2019 NET INCOME DOWN -6.6% TO €56.1M

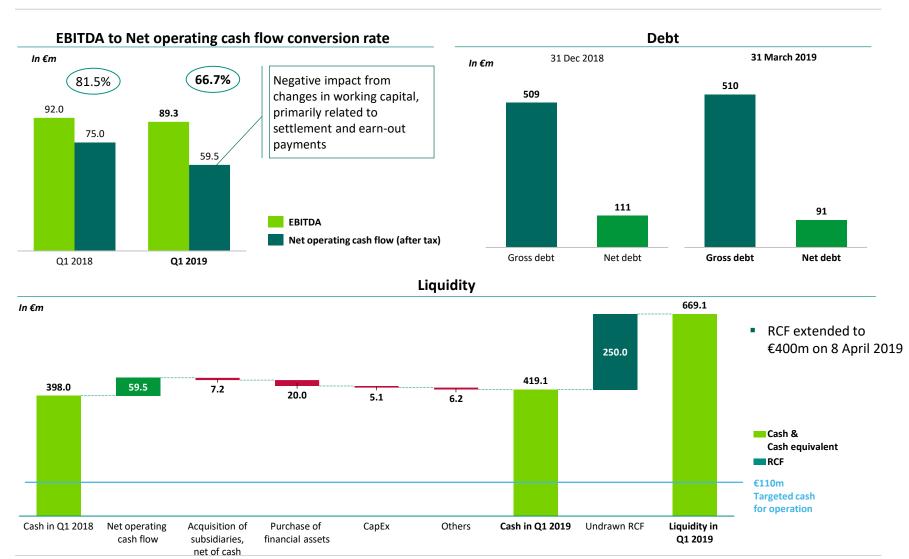
HIGHER RESULTS FROM EQUITY INVESTMENTS AND LOWER TAX RATE

III.Oslo Børs VPSacquisition – next steps



EURONEXT AIMS TO ACQUIRE UP TO 100% OF OSLO BØRS VPS

Euronext as a suitable owner of 100% of Oslo Børs VPS with 53.4% of capital already secured

- On 14 January 2019, Euronext launched its Offer to acquire up to 100% of Oslo Børs VPS
- The Managing Board and the Supervisory Board of Euronext have unanimously approved the transaction and unanimously recommend that Euronext shareholders vote in favour of the transaction at the Annual General Meeting
- The Reference Shareholders of Euronext N.V., who jointly hold 23.86% of the issued share capital of Euronext, have confirmed their joint support to Euronext for this transaction
- Euronext has received on 28 March 2019 the Declaration of Non-Objection from its College of Regulators
- On 8 April 2019, the Norwegian Financial Supervisory Authority (Finanstilsynet) has recommended the Norwegian Ministry of Finance that Euronext should be approved as a suitable owner of up to 100% of the capital of Oslo Børs VPS
- On 13 May 2019, Euronext received clearance from the Norwegian Ministry of Finance to acquire up to 100% of Oslo Børs VPS's capital
- Euronext confirms that it will ensure that all remaining shareholders will get an opportunity to tender their shares to Euronext at the same terms in connection following final regulatory approval and fulfilment of all offer conditions, through an extended, new or re-opened offer

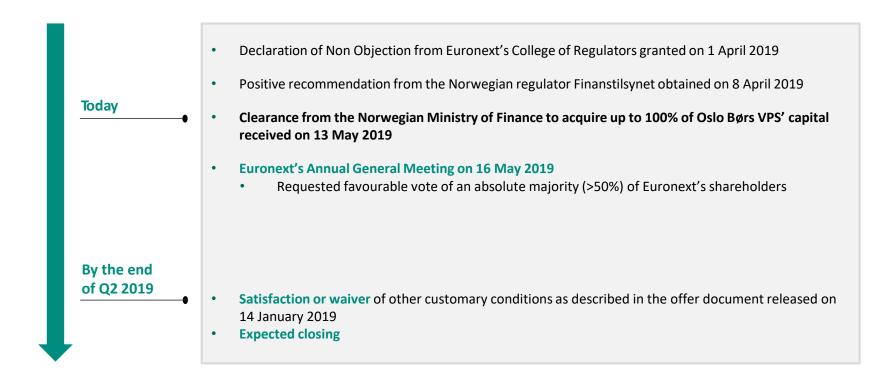

P&L IMPACT IN 2019 OF THE ADOPTION OF IFRS16

Due to the adoption of IFRS 16 on 1 January 2019, Euronext reported in Q1 2019 a €2.7m positive impact on its EBITDA, a slightly positive impact on its operating profit (€0.1m) and an unsignificant impact on its net income. This impact in Q1 2019 is expected to be similar for the four quarters of 2019.
