### INTRODUCTION

- (1) This Notice is issued by Oslo Børs ASA [ ] 2026 as a supplement to Euronext Oslo Rule Book II section 2.7 and enters into force on 10 July 2026.
- (2) This Notice provides further requirements for the submission of information in accordance with what will apply under the Transparency Directive (Directive 2004/109/EC) to the European Single Access Point (“ESAP”). The EU legal acts on ESAP (primarily Regulation (EU) 2023/2859 and Commission Regulation (EU) 2025/1338) and the Transparency Directive (Directive 2004/109/EC) have not been implemented into Norwegian law. The obligation for issuers to submit information to ESAP is, until such implementation occurs, included in Euronext Oslo Rule Book II section 2.7 and this Notice.

### 1. ABOUT ESAP

The European Single Access Point (ESAP) is a European portal for access to financial information. Euronext Oslo Børs is the collection body for information to be submitted to ESAP. Issuers must therefore submit information to Euronext Oslo Børs, which will store the information and forward it to ESAP.

### 2. SUBMISSION TO EURONEXT OSLO BØRS

Submission to Euronext Oslo Børs shall be carried out in the same manner and in the same operation as submission to the Officially Appointed Mechanism (OAM) via NewsPoint. Issuers may alternatively use a third-party capable of delivering information directly to Euronext Oslo Børs.

Information to be submitted to ESAP consists of information subject to OAM obligation pursuant to the Securities Trading Act § 5-12 first paragraph third sentence, as well as information the issuer is required to disclose under Euronext Oslo Rule Book II, with the exception of sections 4.2.5.3 and 4.5.

### **3. METADATA**

Information submitted to ESAP must include specified metadata.

The following metadata will be provided with each submission:

- Whether the disclosure contains personal data
- Date or period from
- Date or period to
- LEI of the entity
- Type of information
- Size of entity
- Industry sector
- Date/time of submission
- Collection body
- Home member state
- Host member state
- Type of submission
- Version number
  
- Name of submitting entity (for major shareholding notifications only)
- LEI of submitting entity (for major shareholding notifications only)
- Size of submitting entity (for major shareholding notifications only)

### **4. REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTACHMENTS**

When submitting attachments, the system will automatically verify that the attachment complies with applicable requirements:

- Scanned or image-based PDF files are not accepted
- The attachment must be a genuine PDF, not a file merely given the .pdf extension
- The attachment must contain searchable text
- The attachment must not be password-protected
- When using ZIP or XBRL, the files must comply with detailed requirements set by ESMA

## **5. NUMBER AND SIZE OF ATTACHMENTS**

Each submission may contain up to ten attachments. The maximum file size for each attachment is 200 MB, and the total size of all attachments must not exceed 500 MB.

The user documentation for NewsPoint contains a description of the submission of information to ESAP. The documentation will be updated on an ongoing basis without further notice.
