

OPTIQ PHASE 2: OEG HIGH AVAILABILITY CONFORMANCE TESTING, TCS CONFORMANCE SCRIPTS AND V-EUA UNAVAILABILITY ON 19 APRIL MORNING

Summary

Euronext informs customers that OEG High Availability (HA) testing is now available. Tests are planned in the Virtual EUA (V-EUA) environment on the Funds segment. Customers are reminded that HA conformance is mandatory and are invited to fill in the following [SBE](#) and [FIX](#) web forms once they have completed their tests. TCS conformance scripts are also available in the updated [conformance script document](#). Finally, the V-EUA environment will be closed on Thursday 19 April until 13:00 CET for maintenance purposes.

High availability testing in V-EUA

HA conformance testing

Customers are reminded that HA is part of the conformance testing on Optiq Phase 2.

The web forms for the [SBE](#) and [FIX](#) protocols are available on [Connect](#).

Customers are required to fill in the form(s) once they have completed their tests.

The scope of HA tests is described in the Optiq Phase 2 conformance scripts available in the [conformance section](#) of the Optiq documentation page.

Customers who experience issues with HA mechanisms or who do not support fully automated mechanisms are invited to contact the Optiq Support Desk.

Outstanding bugs on HA

Due to an existing bug, the sequence number provided by the Exchange in the connection ack message can be higher than expected (when the sequence number of the cancel on disconnect is not taken into account properly) or lower than expected. As described in the documentation, in the case of a failover, customers are invited to reconnect with the sequence number provided by the Exchange. When doing this, recovery mechanisms will allow the resynchronisation in an automated way. EMS will provide support to customers if this occurs and until the bug is resolved.

Due to an existing bug on the SBE protocol, in the case of a failover, customers are invited to reconnect with the last received sequence number minus 1.
